The race will take place in Calstock, near Gunnislake, on the Cornish Bank of the River Tamar. Race check in, prize giving, briefing and refreshments will be inside the village hall.

Race Prizes of an Icon Gift Voucher up to the value of £60 will be presented to the winners of division 1-10 K1 and the top K2 over each race distance. Any paddler that is clearly racing in the wrong division or is promoted two divisions will not be eligible. Entries: By email preferably via the new race management programme to foweyrivercc@gmail.com. Please pre enter before 22.00 on Thursday 9th May after which a £3 late entry fee will apply.

We request that Team Leaders attend check in on behalf of your members and pre-pay via bank transfer for entries where possible. Bank details will be provided upon receipt of your entry.

Camping: To assist those traveling to the event, and due to the early high tide, we have arranged free camping on the football field for competitors, please contact the club should you wish to make use of this.

Buoyancy Aids:

Buoyancy aids must be worn by all paddlers in divisions 7-10 irrespective of class entered. All juniors must wear buoyancy aids with the exception of paddlers ranked in Division 6 and above where the paddler's Team Leader has agreed that a buoyancy aid need not be worn. The race organisers may request that all or some paddlers in addition to the above may need to wear buoyancy aids; the race organisers' decision is final.

Rules: Races as per Marathon division rules.
Note that club vests/colours must be worn to claim Hasler points.

Course: The Course will take place on the tidal River Tamar. Shoes are recommended due to the possibility of a muddy egress point. There will be no portages for any division.

Car Parking: Overflow Car parking will be available on the football field next to the main car park.

Additional Info:

Both Sea Kayaks and Surf Skis are encouraged to attend this race and will be eligible for club points. The South West number boards will be used for this event, please be aware failing to return your number will incur a £5 charge.
