portages. Out and back 1 turn
Divisions 7, 8, 9 & 10 singles and 7, 8, & 9 doubles 4 miles, no
portages. Out and back
Lightning race 2 miles

4, 8 and 12 mile courses Briefing 11.30 Start 12-00
Lightning Briefing 11-00 Start 11.15

The starts and finishes will be adjacent to the clubhouse.

Refreshments Light refreshments will be available to competitors and a
variety of hot and cold refreshments will be on sale.

Rules All division 7,8,9 &10 and lightning paddlers must wear
approved buoyancy aids. All boats must have buoyancy
to keep the boat and crew afloat in the event of a capsize
and be fitted with a white number plate. The race will be
held in accordance with B C marathon racing rules.
Current BC cards must be shown at the booking-in.
A BC event fee of £5.00 is payable for non-BC members
and those unable to prove their membership in divisions
7-10. Divisions 1-6 are not allowed to race without proof of
BC membership.

Prizes Prizes will be awarded to first place in all divisions. Second,
third and other categories depending on number entries.

Late entry free of £2.00 will be applied.
