

Important information
for everyone attending the National Sprint Regatta this weekend.

We have been advised by the management of the National Water Sport Centre that due to the prolonged period of wet weather it is **not safe to park on any of the grass areas** on the site. All parking will be on hardstanding areas.

For this regatta, if you arrive at the Elms Gate you will be directed to the left (not the right), cars will be allowed to park in front of the Grandstand seating area, also, all along the lakeside roadway down to the Boatbays at the far end of the course. Parking along the roadway will be restricted to a single row only. Further parking will be on the hardstanding at the end of the course in front of the Boatbays.

If you can 'Car share', please do so as space will be very tight, vehicles will have to be parked closer together than usual.

Unfortunately, it is unlikely there will be space for gazebos/tents/shelters between the vehicles, but there will be space for club tents/gazebos etc., on the back of the hardstanding behind the Trade stands in the Patio Lawn area. Clubs are more than welcome to pitch a shelter there.

There will be the usual Marshalls collecting the parking charge as you enter the site and other Marshalls to direct traffic please follow their directions.

Do not park on any grass areas, they are waterlogged
