### 2019 Canoe Sprint World Championship Team

Selection for the 2019 Senior World Championships was based upon performances achieved at the 2019 ICF World Cup races at Poznan, POL and Duisburg, GER as outlined in the published [policy](#). The purpose of this statement is to clarify the final GBR team entry to assist transparency.
